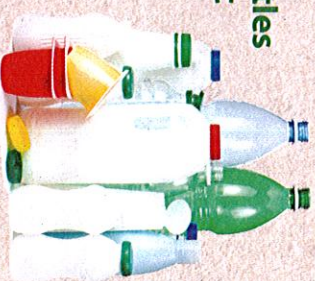

QUICK RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Styrofoam is NOT recyclable.
